AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GLASGOW, MISSOURI, GRANTING TO THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR AUTHORITY OVER APPOINTMENT AND DISCHARGE OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEE POSITIONS WITHIN THE CITY; AMENDING THE JOB DESCRIPTION OF CITY ADMINISTRATOR BY REPEALING SECTION 5.20 OF THE GLASGOW CITY EMPLOYEE MANUAL AND ADOPTING NEW SECTION 5.20 OF THE GLASGOW CITY EMPLOYEE MANUAL IN ITS PLACE; TIME WHEN ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT.

WHEREAS, Section 77.046, RSMo. provides, that the City may provide that employees of the city, except elected officers, may be appointed and discharged by the city administrator, subject to rules and regulations governing the same; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen of the City of Glasgow desire to delegate the duty of appointing and discharging certain employees to the City Administrator;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF GLASGOW, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Administrator is hereby given the authority to appoint and discharge non-elected employees of the City of Glasgow, except that all decisions relative to the appointing and discharge of the City Clerk, Superintendent of Public Works, City Attorney, City Administrator, and Chief of Police shall remain solely within the discretion of the Board of Aldermen.

Section 2. Section 5.20 of the City of Glasgow Personnel Manual is hereby repealed in its entirety and new Section 5.20 is adopted in its place

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
