A LOCAL LAW AMENDING THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF GOSHEN,
CHAPTER 89 ENTITLED “VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC”, ARTICLE II “STOP
INTERSECTIONS”**

BE IT ENACTED, by the Town Board of the Town of Goshen, Orange County, New York as follows:

Section 1. Code Amendments

ARTICLE II Stop Intersections

Section 89-5. Designation of Stop Intersections

The following highway intersections located within the Town of Goshen are hereby designed as stop intersections and stop signs shall be erected as follows:
