Local Law No. 10 /2022

A local law amending Section 285-27 of the Code of the Town of Greenburgh entitled "LOB Limited Office Building District" pursuant to New York State Constitution Article IX and New York Municipal Home Rule Law Section 10, New York Environmental Conservation Law Article 8 (SEQR).

BE IT ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of Greenburgh:

§ 1. Title.

This law is entitled "A local law amending Section 285-27 of the Code of the Town of Greenburgh entitled 'LOB Office Building District."

§ 2. Legislative Findings and Intent.

The Town Board of the Town of Greenburgh finds it in the best interest of the Town to amend Section 285-27 of the Code of the Town of Greenburgh to allow fully-enclosed commercial recreation facilities and self-storage uses in the LOB District.

§ 3. Amendments to Chapter 285-27A(1).

Section 285-27A(1) of the Code of the Town of Greenburgh is hereby amended as follows (deleted text in strikeout; new text underlined):

- (n) Self-Storage.
- (o) Fully enclosed commercial recreation facilities consisting of less than 5,000 square feet of gross floor area, and uses accessory and incidental to commercial recreation, such as locker rooms, eating and drinking facilities, and the retail sale of goods associated with the primary activity.

§ 4. Amendments to Chapter 285-27A.

Section 285-27A of the Code of the Town of Greenburgh is hereby amended as follows (deleted text in strikeout; new text underlined):

- (5) Uses under special permit by Planning Board.
 - (a) Fully enclosed commercial recreation facilities consisting of 5,000 square feet of gross floor area or greater, including bowling alleys; health spas and clubs; swimming pools; basketball courts; tennis, paddle tennis, handball and squash facilities; and uses accessory and incidental to commercial recreation, such as locker rooms; eating and drinking facilities; and the retail sale of goods associated with the primary activity, provided that, when the use is proposed in a multitenant building or a multi-use site, the applicant shall demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Planning Board that adequate available peak time parking vacancies exist.

§ 5. Supersession.

Pursuant to New York Municipal Home Rule Law Section 22, this law is intended to supersede any other inconsistent provision of law.

§ 6. Severability.

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section or part of this law or the application to any person or circumstance shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section or part of this law, or its application to the person or circumstance directly involved in the controversy in which such order or judgment shall be rendered.

§ 7. Effective Date.

This law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
