Local Law No. 3 of 2021
of the Village of Groton, County of Tompkins

A local law adopted pursuant to Cannabis Law § 131 opting out of licensing and establishing retail cannabis dispensaries and/or on-site cannabis consumption establishments within the Village of Groton.

Section 1. Legislative Intent

It is the intent of this local law to opt the Village of Groton out of hosting retail cannabis dispensaries and/or on-site cannabis consumption establishments within its boundaries.

Section 2. Authority

This local law is adopted pursuant to Cannabis Law § 131, which expressly authorizes the Village of Groton to opt-out of allowing retail cannabis dispensaries and/or on-site cannabis consumption establishments to locate and operate within their boundaries.

Section 3. Local Cannabis Retail Dispensary and/or On-Site Consumption Opt-Out

The Board of Trustees of the Village of Groton County of Tompkins, hereby opts-out of licensing and establishing cannabis retail dispensaries and/or cannabis on-site consumption establishments within its boundaries.

Section 4. Severability

If a court determines that any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, the court's order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

Section 5. Effective date

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State. Pursuant to Cannabis Law § 131, this local law is subject to a permissive referendum and thus may not be filed with the Secretary of State until the applicable time period has elapsed to file a petition or a referendum has been conducted approving this local law.

Notice is hereby given that the Village Board of the Village of Groton, County of Tompkins, State of New York, at a regular meeting thereof, held on August 16, 2021, duly adopted, subject to a permissive referendum, a resolution, and abstract of which is as follows: RESOLUTION ADOPTING A LOCAL LAW FOR OPTING OUT OF ALLOWING RETAIL CANNABIS DISPENSARIES AND/OR ON-SITE CANNABIS CONSUMPTION ESTABLISHMENTS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF GROTON. The local law, adopted by such resolution of the Village Board, shall become effective 30 days from August 16, 2021 unless a petition is filed with the Village Clerk within 30 days of August 16, 2021 protesting against such law and such petition is signed and authenticated as required by NYS Municipal Home Rule Law § 24 and Article 9 of the Village Law. The petition must be signed by qualified electors of such local government, in number equal to at least twenty per centum (20%) of the total number of residents registered to vote at the last preceding general village election in the Village of Groton. In the event that such petition is so filed and determined by the Village Clerk to be in compliance with the law, the local law adopted by Village Board resolution on August 16, 2021, shall not be effective unless and until approved by the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors of the local government voting on a proposition for its approval.
