



## ORDINANCE NO. 2019-02

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF GREENCASTLE, FRANKLIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING CHAPTER 190 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF GREENCASTLE, ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC", TO ELIMINATE THE LOCATION OF CERTAIN PARKING SPACES ON THE EASTERN SIDE OF NORTH ALLISON STREET.**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Greencastle (hereinafter the "Borough") is authorized to regulate the parking of vehicles along sidewalks pursuant to Section 1202(13) of the Borough Code, 8 Pa.C.S. § 1202(13), and to regulate parking and provide parking accommodations to promote the convenience and protection of the public pursuant to Section 1202(31) of the Borough Code, 8 Pa.C.S. § 1202(31); and,

**WHEREAS**, the Borough desires to eliminate the location of certain parking spaces on the eastern side of North Allison Street; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the Borough of Greencastle deems it in the best interest and for the general welfare of the citizens and residents of the Borough to amend certain provisions of Chapter 190 of the Code of the Borough of Greencastle.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Greencastle, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, and it is enacted and ordained as follows:

**SECTION 1:** Chapter 190 of the Code of the Borough of Greencastle, entitled "Vehicles and Traffic", Section 27 thereof, entitled "Parking Prohibited At All Times In Certain Locations", Subsection A thereof, is hereby amended to include the following location:

<b>Street</b>	<b>Side</b>	<b>Location</b>
N. Allison Street	East	From the intersection of N. Allison Street and Madison Street extending north to a point a distance of 105 feet beyond the intersection

**SECTION 2: REPEALER.** All provisions of previous Ordinances of the Borough of Greencastle which are contrary to this Ordinance are expressly repealed.

**SECTION 3: SAVINGS CLAUSE.** In all other respects, Chapter 190 of the Code Borough of Greencastle shall remain as previously enacted and ordained.

**SECTION 4: SEVERABILITY.** The provisions of this Ordinance are severable and if any of its sections, clauses, or sentences shall be held illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional, such provisions shall not affect or impair any of the remaining sections, clauses or sentences.

**SECTION 5: EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.


