

**AN ORDINANCE RATIFYING THE CERTIFIED RESULTS
OF THE MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD IN THE
CITY OF GREENWOOD HELD ON APRIL 7, 2026**

WHEREAS, on Tuesday, April 7, 2026, a Municipal General Election was held within the City of Greenwood for the purpose of electing the Mayor, a member of the Board of Aldermen from Ward I, and a member of the Board of Aldermen from Ward II, within the City; and

WHEREAS, the certified results, which are attached to this Ordinance, have been received by the City of Greenwood from the Jackson County Board of Election Commissioners and the Cass County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen find that it is in the best interest of the City to accept and ratify the election results as presented;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF GREENWOOD, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Declaration and Ratification of April 7, 2026, Election Results. That the Certification of Election results received from the Jackson County Board of Election Commissioners, and the County Clerk of Cass County declaring the results of the 2026 City of Greenwood General Municipal Election, which are attached hereto, are hereby received and ratified by the City of Greenwood as follows:


Section 2. Repeal of Ordinances in Conflict. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
