

ORDINANCE NO. 24-27

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLES 1.50.526 OF THE CITY OF GRANBURY, TEXAS, CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR THE ADDITION OF NEW FEES AND AMENDMENT OF CERTAIN OTHER FEES ADOPTED BY SAID ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Granbury, Texas, is a home rule city acting under its charter adopted by the electorate pursuant to Article XI, Section 5 of the Texas Constitution, and Chapter 9 of the Local Government Code; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Granbury has adopted fees and charges for various City services, licenses and permits in the form of a Master Fee schedule and codified as Article 1.50 of the Granbury Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it appropriate to add and amend certain fees and charges for various City Services, licenses and permits in the Master Fee Schedule.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRANBURY, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.

That Articles 1.50.518 Electric Utility Service of the City of Granbury Master Fee Schedule is hereby amended, as shown on the attached and incorporated as Exhibit "A" hereto.

SECTION 2.

This Ordinance and Master Fee Schedule incorporated herein, shall supersede any and all previous ordinances which set forth fees and charges, and any and all previous versions of the Master Fee Schedule.

SECTION 3.

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, or section of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs or sections of this ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation in this ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.

SECTION 4.


This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on May 1, 2024, and after the date of its passage and publication as required by law, and it is so ordained.

Garbage collection is a taxable service and will be subject to state, county and local tax rates.

Any commercial/industrial establishment which does not contract directly with the City's contractor shall be assessed a monthly sanitation collection fee equal to the rate listed in subsection (d) for once a week commercial hand collection. Such fee shall be added to the customer's monthly utility bill.

Definitions:

Contractor - a private firm that the city contracts with for the collection, transportation, and/or disposal of solid waste and the collection and processing of recyclable materials.

Small business - business offices or non-restaurant retail business with square footage of less than 2,600 sq. feet as defined by the Certificate of Occupancy.

Large business - all commercial customers that are larger than those classified as small business, non-

Small restaurant - An eating establishment, including but not limited to: coffee shops, cafeterias, sandwich

Large restaurant - same as small restaurant with alcoholic beverage sales.
