ORDINANCE NO. 24-43

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLES 1.50 OF THE CITY OF GRANBURY, TEXAS, CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR THE ADDITION OF NEW FEES AND AMENDMENT OF CERTAIN OTHER FEES ADOPTED BY SAID ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Granbury, Texas, is a home rule city acting under its charter adopted by the electorate pursuant to Article XI, Section 5 of the Texas Constitution, and Chapter 9 of the Local Government Code; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Granbury has adopted fees and charges for various City services, licenses and permits in the form of a Master Fee schedule and codified as Article 1.50 of the Granbury Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it appropriate to add and amend certain fees and charges for various City Services, licenses and permits in the Master Fee Schedule.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRANBURY, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.

That Articles 1.50 Master Fee Schedule of the City of Granbury is hereby amended, as shown on the attached and incorporated as Exhibit "A" hereto.

SECTION 2.

This Ordinance and Master Fee Schedule incorporated herein, shall supersede any and all previous ordinances which set forth fees and charges, and any and all previous versions of the Master Fee Schedule.

SECTION 3.

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, or section of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the

remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs or sections of this ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation in this ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.

SECTION 4.

This Ordinance shall be effective on October 1, 2024.

Sec. 1.50.701 Rental Fee for Fire Training Center

For one (1) day each calendar month, the City allows the Fire Training Center to be accessible to all Hood County volunteer fire departments. If provided by the City, the Hood County fire departments <u>will</u> be charged for hay and propane usage at cost.

Additional reservation days will be charged as follows:

(a) Paid Fire Departments

i. Per Day (up to 5 hours)	\$300
ii. Each Additional Hour	\$100
iii. Per Day (Site Manager/Facility Manager)	\$65

(b) Volunteer Fire Departments both Hood County & Non-Hood County

i. Per Day (up to 5 hours)	\$125
ii. Each Additional Hour	\$50
iii. Per Day (Site Manager/Facility Manager)	\$65
