

ORDINANCE NO. 24-006

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, TEXAS, AMENDING ASSIGNMENT PAY TITLES FOR CIVIL SERVICE EMPLOYEES OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO COMPLY WITH STATE LEGISLATIVE UPDATES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the city adopted Civil Service, Chapter 143 of the Texas Local Government Code for certain employees of the City of Greenville Police Department; and

WHEREAS, according to the Texas Local Government Code §143.042 Assignment Pay, the governing body of a municipality may authorize assignment pay for fire fighters and police officers who perform specialized functions in their respective department; and

WHEREAS, due to state legislative updates with the passage of House Bill 2190 it is necessary to certain assignment pay titles in the City of Greenville's Police Department's Policy and Procedure Manual; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes it to be in the best interest of the citizens of Greenville to authorize the amendments to assignment pay titles for Civil Service members and approve the updates to the City of Greenville Police Department's Policy and Procedures Manual.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby finds the statements made in the preamble to be true and correct.

SECTION 2. The City Council hereby authorizes the amendments to City of Greenville Police Department's Policy and Procedures Manual assignment pay titles as follows:

Police Assignment Pay


- Remove Emergency Vehicle Instructor because this assignment is no longer offered.
- Remove SABA Instructor as it is now a combined assignment with Reality Based Training.
- Remove Quartermaster due to this now being a full-time paid civilian position.
- Update the title from Reality Based Training Instructor to Reality Based Training/SABA Instructor due to it now being a combined assignment and SABA Instructor being removed as requested above.

- Change Accident Investigator to Collision Investigator due a recent legislative update.

SECTION 3. If any section, provision, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word in this ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holdings shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance, and the City Council of the City of Greenville, Texas hereby declares it would have enacted such remaining portions, despite such invalidity.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage and approval, **AND IT IS SO ORDAINED.**
