ORDINANCE #19-23

**AMENDING CHAPTER VII ENTITLED "TRAFFIC" SUBSECTION 7-3.7 ENTITLED
"PARKING PROHIBITED FOR CERTAIN VEHICLES" OF THE REVISED
GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF GUTTENBERG**

WHEREAS, Chapter 7-3.7 of the Code of the Town of Guttenberg ("Code") entitled "Parking Prohibited For Certain Vehicles" was enacted to ensure no person park certain vehicles upon any street or public thoroughfare in Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Guttenberg seeks to designate motorcycle parking spots and amend the probation of certain vehicles prohibited from parking in full car parking spaces to include motorcycles.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Guttenberg, County of Hudson, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 7-3.7 of the Code of the Town of Guttenberg ("Code") entitled "Parking Prohibited For Certain Vehicles," is hereby amended, as follows:

SECTION ONE

Chapter 7-3.7 of the Code of the Town of Guttenberg ("Code") entitled "Parking Prohibited For Certain Vehicles" shall be amended as follows [Amendments are in bold]:

Parking Prohibited For Certain Vehicles

- a. It shall be unlawful for the owner or operator to park any truck, truck trailer, trailer, van, omnibus, livery, taxi, commercial vehicle, noncommercial truck, commuter van, van pooling vehicle, semi-trailer, all defined in N.J.S.A. 39:1-1, that is over 6,000 pounds, eight feet in height or taller, or exceeds 18 feet in length, upon any street or other public thoroughfare in the Town, on any day of the week between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 6:00 a.m.
- b. It shall be unlawful for the owner or operator of any motorcycle to park in parking spot that is not a designated motorcycle parking spot. For purposes of this Chapter, Motorcycles are defined as they are in N.J.S.A.39:1-1 and shall include motorcycles, autocycles, motor bikes, bicycles with motor attached and all motor-operated vehicles of the bicycle or tricycle type, except motorized bicycles, low-speed electric bicycles, and low-speed electric scooters as defined in this section, whether the motive power be a part thereof or attached thereto and having a saddle or seat with driver sitting astride or upon it or a platform on which the driver stands.
- c. Penalties.

- (i) Any person who violates any provision of subsection a shall, upon conviction thereof, be liable to a penalty of \$124 per violation. Each one hour a particular violation continues shall constitute a separate offense.
- (ii) Any person who violates any provision of subsection b shall, upon conviction thereof, be liable to a penalty of \$60 per violation.

SECTION TWO

Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable and if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase thereof for any reason be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, subsections, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Ordinance, but shall remaining in effect; it being the legislative intent that this Ordinance shall stand notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

SECTION THREE

Repealer. All Ordinances or parts thereof in conflict or inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, but only however, to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency, it being the legislative intent that all Ordinances or part of ordinances now existing or in effect unless the same being conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance shall remain in effect.

SECTION FOUR

This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as required by law.

Summary of Ordinance

The purpose of this ordinance is to is to amend the types of vehicles, motorcycles, from parking in full sized car parking spots and to simultaneously provide designated motorcycle parking spots.
