Section 1: This local law amends Local Law #10 of the year 1986 of the Code of the Town of Hamburg, Chapter 280 entitled "Zoning", to provide for a change in the boundary of the Zoning Map as follows: rezone 15 parcels (with various zoning designations: C-1, C-2 and M-2) around the Camp Road Interchange area with the following SBL numbers to CRI (Camp Road Interchange District): 182.00-2-37.2, 182.00-2-37.11, 182.00-2-38.1, 182.00-2-37.121, 182.07-1-1.11, 182.07-1-6.1, 182.07-1-6.2, 182.00-2-71, 182.00-2-72, 182.07-1-10.1, 182.07-1-9, 182.07-1-11.11, 182.07-1-8, 182.07-1-7.1, and 182.00-2-41.111.

Section 2: This local law to take effect immediately after proper filing, including with the Department of State.


