**A LOCAL LAW AMENDING CHAPTER 214, PEDDLING, VENDING AND SOLICITING,
SECTION 214-8, PROHIBITIONS, TO PROHIBIT VEHICLES FROM STANDING ON CERTAIN
VILLAGE ROADS**

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Hastings-on-Hudson as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 214-8, Prohibitions, subsection B of the Code of the Village of Hastings-on-Hudson is hereby amended to read as follows:

B. Blow a horn, ring a bell, play amplified music when stopped or standing, or use any other noisy device to attract public attention to his wares, or shout or cry out his wares.

SECTION 2. Section 214-8, Prohibitions, subsection C of the Code of the Village of Hastings-on-Hudson is hereby amended to read as follows:

C. Stand or permit the vehicle used by him to stand in one place, in any public place or street, for more than 10 minutes, or in front of any premises for any time if the owner or lessee of the ground floor thereof objects, or in any place if traffic is thereby obstructed. After 10 minutes the vehicle must be moved a minimum of 200 feet.

SECTION 3. Section 214-8, Prohibitions, of the Code of the Village of Hastings-on-Hudson is hereby amended to add a new subsection J as follows:

J. Stand or permit the vehicle owned and/or operated by the licensee to stand at any time at the following locations:

1. Spring Street.
2. Main Street.

3. Warburton Avenue, between Broadway and Washington Avenue.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY

If any section, subsection, clause, phrase or other portion of this Local Law is, for any reason, declared invalid, in whole or in part, by any court, agency, commission, legislative body or other authority of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent portion. Such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof, which other portions shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the office of the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
