

**ORDINANCE 2026:1583**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF HADDON HEIGHTS AMENDING PART II, GENERAL LEGISLATION, CHAPTER 301, ENTITLED “NOISE”, WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF HADDON HEIGHTS, IN THE COUNTY OF CAMDEN AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Haddon Heights ("Borough") is a municipal corporation organized and operating under the laws of the State of New Jersey; and

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 301, entitled “Noise”, sets forth hours during which certain activities are prohibited; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Borough Council believe it to be in the best interest of the Borough’s health, safety and welfare to make certain modifications and amendments to the Borough Code with respect to Chapter 301; and

**WHEREAS** pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:48-2, the Mayor and Council of the Borough are authorized to enact and amend ordinances as deemed necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and as may be necessary to carry into effect the powers and duties conferred and imposed upon the Borough by law.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Haddon Heights, County of Camden and State of New Jersey, of the Borough Code, shall be amended as follows:

**SECTION 1:** Part II, General Legislation, Chapter 301 “Noise”, specifically 301-1, Hours during which certain activities are prohibited is hereby amended to read as follows:

The activities hereafter listed shall be prohibited other than the hours herein listed:

- A. Weekdays: 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- B. Saturdays: 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. for all activities except landscaping which shall be permitted from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- C. Sundays and holidays: 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. for all activities except landscaping which shall be permitted from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

**SECTION 2:** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**SECTION 3:** Each section, subsection, sentence, clause, and phrase of this Ordinance is declared to be an independent section, subsection, sentence, clause, and phrase, and finding or holding of any such portion


of this Ordinance to be unconstitutional, void, or ineffective for any cause or reason shall not affect any other portion of this Ordinance.


**SECTION 4:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and any publication as may be required by law.
