

**ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HAMILTON, NEW JERSEY, CHAPTER 485, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE II, PARKING, § 485-19, HANDICAPPED PARKING (Repealing spaces established at 217 Main Street by Ordinance No. 08-046 and 103 Parker Place by Ordinance No. 92-012)**

Whereas the Township of Hamilton, in the County of Mercer has received requests to repeal certain handicapped parking spaces that were established on streets for private residences;

Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Township of Hamilton, in the County of Mercer and State of New Jersey, that the Code of Ordinances of Hamilton Township, New Jersey, Chapter 485, Vehicles and Traffic, Article II, Parking, § 485-19, Handicapped Parking, as amended and supplemented, be further amended and supplemented as follows:

**Chapter 485**

**VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC**

**Article II – Parking**

**§ 485-19. Handicapped parking.**

- B. Handicapped parking on streets for private residences. In accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-197.6, the following on-street locations are designated as handicapped parking spaces in front of private residences occupied by handicapped persons. Such spaces are for use by persons who have been issued special identification cards or plates or placards by the Motor Vehicle Commission or a temporary placard issued by the Chief of Police. No other person shall be permitted in these spaces.

Street	Location
[217 Main Street Groveville, New Jersey 08620]	[In front of 216 Main Street, Beginning at a point 93 feet of the curb line of Church Street and extending to a point 115 feet of the curb line of Main Street]

[103 Parker Place Trenton, New Jersey 08609]	[Beginning at a point eighty-nine (89') feet northerly of the northeast corner of Parker Place and Hollywood Drive and extending northerly to a point twenty-two (22') feet therefrom.]

Any Ordinance or Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final adoption and publication thereof according to law.
