

ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HAMILTON, NEW JERSEY, CHAPTER 485, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE II, PARKING; § 485-19, HANDICAPPED PARKING (Establishing spaces for 34 Adella Avenue; 157 Caroline Avenue; 109 Henry Street; and 24 Park Lane)

Whereas the Township of Hamilton, in the County of Mercer has received requests to establish handicapped parking spaces on streets for private residences;

Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Township of Hamilton, in the County of Mercer and State of New Jersey, that the Code of Ordinances of Hamilton Township, New Jersey, Chapter 485, Vehicles and Traffic, Article II; Parking, § 485-19, Handicapped Parking, as amended and supplemented, be further amended and supplemented as follows:

Chapter 485

VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

Article II – Parking

.....

§ 485-19. Handicapped parking.

.....

- B. Handicapped parking on streets for private residences. In accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-197.6, the following on-street locations are designated as handicapped parking spaces in front of private residences occupied by handicapped persons. Such spaces are for use by persons who have been issued special identification cards or plates or placards by the Motor Vehicle Commission or a temporary placard issued by the Chief of Police. No other person shall be permitted in these spaces.

<u>Street</u>	<u>Location</u>
<u>34 Adella Avenue</u> <u>Hamilton, New Jersey 08609</u>	<u>Beginning at a point 43 feet west of Rosalia Avenue and extending to a point 61 feet west of Rosalia Avenue along the north side curb line of Adella Avenue, in front of the residence.</u>
<u>157 Caroline Avenue</u> <u>Hamilton, New Jersey 08610</u>	<u>Beginning at a point 256 feet north of Benton Road and extending to a point 276 feet north of Benton Road along the west side curb line of Caroline Avenue, in front of the residence.</u>



<u>109 Henry Street</u> <u>Hamilton, New Jersey 08611</u>	<u>Beginning at a point 47 feet east of Hewitt Avenue and extending to a point 66 feet east of Hewitt Avenue along the south side curb line of Henry Street, in front of the residence.</u>
<u>24 Park Lane</u> <u>Hamilton, New Jersey 08609</u>	<u>Beginning at a point 190 feet south of East State Street and extending to a point 209 feet south of East State Street along the east side curb line of Park Lane, in front of the residence.</u>

Any Ordinance or Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.


