

ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HAMILTON, NEW JERSEY, PART II, GENERAL LEGISLATION, CHAPTER 435, STREETS AND SIDEWALKS, ARTICLE II, STREET EXCAVATIONS, § 435-15, RESTORATION OF PAVEMENT

Be It Ordained by the Council of the Township of Hamilton, in the County of Mercer and State of New Jersey, that the *Code of the Township of Hamilton, New Jersey, Part II, General Legislation, Chapter 435, Streets and Sidewalks, Article II, Street Excavations, § 435-15, Restoration of pavement*, as amended and supplemented, be further amended and supplemented as follows:

CHAPTER 435

STREETS AND SIDEWALKS

ARTICLE II – STREET EXCAVATIONS

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§ 435-15. Restoration of pavement.

In connection with the restoration of the original pavement in an excavation made by municipal or utility corporations in improved class A and class B roads, the following rules shall govern:

- A. The foundation shall be restored to a width of 12 inches wider than the width of the trench and six inches longer than the length of the trench.
- B. The surface pavement shall extend 12 inches wider than the width of the foundation and six inches longer than the length of the foundation.
- C. In all cases the foundation shall be nine inches thick, composed of cement concrete of a mixture, by volume, of one part cement, three parts sand and five parts stone. Cement concrete foundations shall be slab shape and not less than nine inches in depth.
- D. Cold-patch asphalt repair is not permitted unless in the instance of an emergency, whereupon cold-patch shall be used as a temporary surface and replaced with hot-mix base to grade asphalt within a 48 hour period.

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
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[D] E. Municipal or utility corporations operating under agreement and bond with the Township must install the restored foundation as well as the restored surface of all openings in improved class A and class B roads. It may be omitted from openings made prior to reconstruction and over openings made in unimproved roads.

Any Ordinance or Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.


