Be It Ordained by the Council of the Township of Hamilton, in the County of Mercer and State of New Jersey, that the *Code of the Township of Hamilton, New Jersey*, Chapter 385, *Sewers and Sewage Disposal,* Article III, *Connection to Sanitary Sewer Required; Exceptions,* § 385-13, *Connection fee; permit,* as amended and supplemented, be further amended and supplemented as follows:

Chapter 385

SEWERS AND SEWAGE DISPOSAL

ARTICLE III - CONNECTION TO SANITARY SEWER REQUIRED; EXCEPTIONS

.....

§ 385-13. Connection fee; permit.

- A. Each applicant for a permit for each connection from a single-family residential dwelling to the sewer system shall pay a fee as set forth in Chapter **215**, Fees, of the Township Code for a permit to make the connection. The fee shall be payable at the time of the issuance of a permit.
- B. Each applicant for each connection from a nonresidential source to the sewer system shall pay the Township a fee as set forth in Chapter **215**, Fees, of the Township Code. For purposes of computing the fee, a unit shall be measured to the following schedule:
