ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HAMILTON, NEW JERSEY, CHAPTER 485, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE II, PARKING, § 485-19, HANDICAPPED PARKING (Repealing spaces established at 18 Bismark Avenue by Ordinance No. 21-056; 16 Charlotte Avenue by Ordinance No. 24-002; 184 Main Street by Ordinance No 20-008 and 434 Schiller Avenue by Ordinance No. 20-002)

Whereas the Township of Hamilton, in the County of Mercer has received requests to repeal certain handicapped parking spaces that were established on streets for private residences;

Now, Therefore, Be It Ordained by the Council of the Township of Hamilton, in the County of Mercer and State of New Jersey, that the Code of Ordinances of Hamilton Township, New Jersey, Chapter 485, Vehicles and Traffic, Article II, Parking, § 485-19, Handicapped Parking, as amended and supplemented, be further amended and supplemented as follows:

Chapter 485

VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC

Article II – Parking

§ 485-19. Handicapped parking.

- B. Handicapped parking on streets for private residences. In accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-197.6, the following on-street locations are designated as handicapped parking spaces in front of private residences occupied by handicapped persons. Such spaces are for use by persons who have been issued special identification cards or plates or placards by the Motor Vehicle Commission or a temporary placard issued by the Chief of Police. No other person shall be permitted in these spaces.

<i>Street</i>	<i>Location</i>
[18 Bismark Avenue Hamilton, New Jersey 08610]	[Beginning at a point 164 feet south of Dewey Avenue and extending to a point 186 feet south of Dewey Avenue along the east curb line of Bismark Avenue.]
[16 Charlotte Avenue Hamilton, New Jersey 08629]	[Beginning at a point 263 feet south of Hamilton Avenue and extending to a point 283 feet south of Hamilton Avenue, along the east side curb line of Charlotte Avenue, in front of the residence.]
[184 Main Street Hamilton, New Jersey 08620]	[Beginning at a point 360 feet south of Church Street and extending to a point 382 feet south of Church Street along the west bound curb line of Main Street.]




