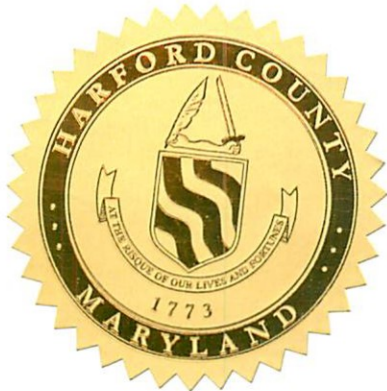

1 Section 1. Be It Enacted By The County Council of Harford County, Maryland that Article II,
2 Fees, of Chapter 157, Licenses and Permits, and of the Harford County Code, as amended, be, and
3 they are hereby, repealed and reenacted, with amendments, all to read as follows:

4 **Chapter 157. Licenses and Permits**

5 **Article II. Fees**

6 **§ 157-3. Applications for license; contents; [refund of] fees.**

7 ...

8 B. Every application for a license or permit shall contain the name of the applicant and the place
9 of business of such applicant. IF THE APPLICANT IS A SOLE PROPRIETORSHIP, THE
10 APPLICATION SHALL CONTAIN THE NAME AND RESIDENCE ADDRESS OF ITS
11 OWNER; [If the applicant is] IF a [partnership, or firm,]LIMITED LIABILITY
12 COMPANY, the application shall contain the names and residence addresses of all its
13 members; if a PARTNERSHIP, GENERAL PARTNERSHIP, limited partnership, OR
14 LIMITED LIABILITY PARTNERSHIP, the names and residence addresses of the [general]
15 partners; and if a corporation, the names and residence addresses of its principal officers. In
16 addition to such statements, there shall be set forth such other material information as the
17 Department of Inspections, Licenses and Permits or other issuing agency prescribes.

18 [C. Whenever a license is not approved or is refused, any fee paid in advance shall be refunded
19 to the applicant.] PRIOR TO THE ISSUANCE OF ANY PERMIT OR LICENSE UNDER
20 THIS CHAPTER, THE APPLICANT SHALL PAY TO THE COUNTY A FEE IN
21 ACCORDANCE WITH THE SCHEDULE OF FEES SET FORTH IN THE HARFORD
22 COUNTY CODE. FEES SHALL BE REASONABLY CALCULATED TO SUFFICIENT
23 FUNDS PROPORTIONATE TO THE COST OF ADMINISTERING AND ENFORCING

1 THE CODES AND LAWS OF THE COUNTY.

2 D. WHERE NO WORK HAS BEEN DONE UNDER A PERMIT ISSUED UNDER THIS
3 CHAPTER, THE HOLDER OF THE PERMIT MAY DELIVER THE PERMIT TO THE
4 DEPARTMENT AND UPON CANCELLATION THEREOF, SHALL BE REFUNDED
5 50% OF THE FEE PAID THEREFOR, OR SUCH OTHER AMOUNT AS SPECIFIED
6 HEREIN, PROVIDED THAT APPLICATION OF THE REFUND IS MADE WITHIN 6
7 MONTHS OF THE ISSUANCE OF THE PERMIT.

8 E. APPLICATION FEES PAID PURSUANT TO THIS CHAPTER SHALL BE
9 NONREFUNDABLE UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED HEREIN.

10 **§ 157-16 Building permits.**

11 [A. Prior to the issuance of any permit or license, the applicant shall pay to the county a fee in
12 accordance with the schedule of fees set forth in the Harford County Code. Fees shall be
13 reasonably calculated to provide, insofar as practicable, sufficient funds to provide for the
14 cost of administering and enforcing the codes and laws of the county.

15 B. Where no work has been done under a permit issued under this chapter, the holder of the
16 permit may deliver the permit to the Department, and upon cancellation thereof shall be
17 refunded 50% of the fee paid therefor, provided that application of the refund is made
18 within 6 months of the issuance of the permit.

19 C. When a permit is disapproved or withdrawn, the applicant shall be refunded 50% of the fee
20 paid.]

21 [D.]A. The following fees shall be charged for building permits. All fees apply to each unit.
22 However, square foot costs include those usable portions of a structure that are enclosed,
23 including basement or cellars. Attics and top-half storage, where the ceiling is less than 7

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1 1/3 feet (88 inches), are excluded.

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
