

**BOROUGH OF HALEDON
ORDINANCE NO. 3-26-2026**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH
OF HALEDON, IN THE COUNTY OF PASSAIC, STATE OF NEW JERSEY,
TO AMEND CHAPTER 205 (VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC)
OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF HALEDON**

WHEREAS, under N.J.S.A. 39:4-197, a municipality may enact ordinances to designate certain parking areas on roadways under municipal control for use by person who have been issued special vehicle identification cards by the New Jersey Division of Motor Vehicles,

WHEREAS, it is necessary to update and amend the Municipal Code to include additional parking areas on roadways and to remove those which are no longer necessary to serve the needs of the persons identified herein; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Council has found it proper to amend the language of the Code accordance therewith;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Municipal Council of the Borough of Haledon, that Chapter 205, Vehicles and Traffic, of the Code of the Borough of Haledon, is hereby amended and supplemented as follows (underlined to be added and ~~striketrough~~ to be deleted):

§205-19 Restriction of Spaces.

A. Residential locations.

Name of Street	Location
<u>32 Sherwood Ave.</u>	<u>From the West corner of Sherwood Ave. and John Ryle Ave. extending one-hundred twenty Seven (127 ft) South on Sherwood Avenue and then continuing West for 22 ft.</u>
<u>393 Southside Avenue.</u>	<u>From the East corner of Tilt Street and Southside Avenue one hundred feet (100 ft) East on Southside Avenue and then continued East for 22 ft.</u>
<u>315 Belmont Ave</u>	<u>From the South West corner of Belmont Ave. and Barbour Street extending fifty feet (50 ft) West onto Barbour Street and Then continuing West another twenty two feet (22ft)</u>

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that:

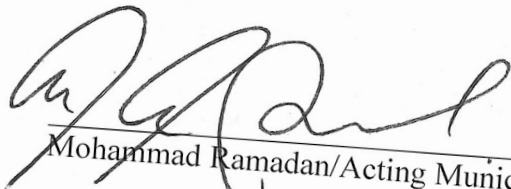
1. Ordinances, resolutions and regulations or parts of ordinances, resolutions and regulations inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency; and
2. If any section, subsection, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such a decision shall not affect the remaining portion of the Ordinance; and
3. Except as hereby amended, the Code of the Borough of Haledon shall remain in full force and effect.

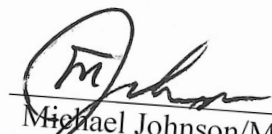
4. Borough Police Department shall have the authority to place such signs as deemed necessary to advise the public of the parking restrictions or remove such signs to reflect that designation has been removed.

5. This Ordinance shall take effect twenty days after final passage and publication in accordance with law.
