

**ORD 1733-24**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF THE  
TOWNSHIP OF HAZLET, CHAPTER 196, ARTICLE VI,  
SECTION 196-9

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Hazlet, in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, that Chapter 196, Article VI, Section 196-9 of the Code of the Township of Hazlet shall be amended to increase the daily parking rate at the Hazlet Railroad Station Parking Lot and establish rules and regulations as follows:

§ 196-9. Fees Established.

C. Daily parking, 60 parking spots: \$4 per day.

D. Rules and Regulations:

1. Daily Parking Permit Hours
  - a. All daily parking passes shall expire at 3:00 AM.
2. Commercial Vehicle Parking Regulations
  - a. Vehicles designated for commercial use shall be prohibited from purchasing annual parking passes.
  - b. Vehicles designated for commercial use shall only be permitted to purchase daily parking passes.
  - c. Vehicles designated for commercial use that are larger than 10 feet wide or longer than 19 feet long are prohibited from parking at the Hazlet Railroad Station Parking Lot.
3. Every vehicle parking at the Hazlet Railroad Train Station shall only be permitted to park in one parking spot.
4. Hazlet Resident Annual Passes and Nonresident Annual Passes are prohibited to be used by vehicles designated for commercial uses.
5. The enforcement of the parking provisions of this section shall be under the control of the Police Department.

6. Each person found guilty of violating any of the provisions of this article shall be liable for a fine of not less than \$ 100.00 no more than \$ 500.00.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that the Municipal Clerk shall publish this ordinance in an official newspaper of the municipality at least one week prior to the hearing on the adoption of this ordinance; and

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that this ordinance shall become effective after second reading and publication as required by law.
