ORDINANCE -1746-24

A CAPITAL ORDINANCE PROVIDING FUNDING FOR VARIOUS SEWER UTILITY IMPROVEMENTS IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF HAZLET, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY, AND APPROPRIATING \$1,000,000 FOR SUCH PURPOSE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HAZLET, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

- <u>Section 1</u>. The Township of Hazlet, in the County of Monmouth, New Jersey, authorizes various sewer utility improvements to be undertaken, including but not limited to repairs, inspections, cleaning, restoration and all work and materials necessary therefore and incidental thereto, for the Township of Hazlet to be funded from the sources specified in Section 2 of the Ordinance.
- <u>Section 2</u>. The amount of \$1,000,000 is hereby appropriated for the purposes stated in Section 1 of the Ordinance and which amount was funded from the Sewer Utility Capital Improvement Fund.
- Section 3. In connection with the purpose and the amount authorized in Sections 1 and 2 hereof, the Township determines the purpose described in Section 1 hereof is not a Current Expense and is an improvement which the Township of Hazlet may lawfully make as a general improvement.
- <u>Section 4</u>. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistency.
- <u>Section 5</u>. That the total amount of the appropriation to be expended for Engineering and inspection costs, legal costs, advertisement of ordinance and other expenses as provided in Section 48:2-20 of the Revised Statutes, is not to exceed \$150,000.00.
- <u>Section 6</u>. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon due passage and publication according to law.
