**§ 115-39. Schedule X: Parking Prohibited at All Times.**

In accordance with the provisions of § 115-13, no person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any of the following described streets or parts of streets:

Liberty Park [Added 9-13-2016]	North	Between Mechanic Street west of curblin e of Mechanic Street and between Liberty Park and 30 feet east of curblin e of Liberty Park
Main Street [Added 7-12-2011]	West	Between Shethar Street and Pulteney Street
Mechanic Street	Both	Between Liberty Street and Lake Street
Myrtle Avenue	North	Between Main Street and Vine Street
Orchard Street [Added 6-10-2008 by L.L. No. 1-2008]	West	Between Lake Street and Myrtle Avenue
Pulteney Street	Both	Between Bauder Avenue and Park Place
Pulteney Street	Both	Between Mechanic Street and the easterly Village line
Shethar Street	Both	Between Mechanic Street and a point 20 feet east of the east curblin e of Mechanic Street
Shethar Street	North	Between Main Street and a point 60 feet east of the east curblin e of Main Street and Church Street
Water Street [Added 9-11-1990]	West	Between Lake Street and William Street
Wheeler Avenue [Added 1-8-1991]	East	Between Lake Street and Davis Avenue
Wheeler Avenue [Added 1-8-1991]	West	Between Davis Avenue and the point where Grape Street intersects Wheeler Avenue
