

ORDINANCE NO. 18-2024

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HANOVER IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF PHASE V OF A MULTI-PHASE PROJECT FOR THE IMPROVEMENT AND MODERNIZATION OF THE TOWNSHIP'S COMMUNICATIONS AND TECHNOLOGY INFRASTRUCTURE WITH THE EXTENSION OF THE FIBER OPTIC NETWORK AND INSTALLATION OF ADDITIONAL SECURITY CAMERAS, WHERE NEEDED, AT CRITICAL INFRASTRUCTURE LOCATIONS IN THE TOWNSHIP, AND FURTHER APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$350,000.00 FROM THE TOWNSHIP'S 2024 CURRENT FUND BUDGET AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND AND ALL PRIOR YEARS FOR FINANCING THE PHASE V IMPROVEMENTS

WHEREAS, in the interest of public safety and the welfare of the Township of Hanover, its residents and the public in general, the Township Committee authorized the implementation of a multi-year, multi-phase project for the improvement and modernization of the Township's communications and technology infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, during calendar years 2020 through 2023, the Township implemented several projects including but not limited to the upgrading of the Police Department's radio communications system, the installation of a fiber optic network for security and telecommunications purposes and installation of security cameras in the Township's parks, recreational facilities and other critical infrastructure locations; and

WHEREAS, based on a January 2020 Technology and Security Review Report prepared for the Township by a technology consultant, the Township Committee desires to implement Phase V of its multi-phase infrastructure improvement plan with the extension of the Township's fiber optic network on certain streets in the Township including the installation of fiber optic to connect the Hanover Sewerage Authority's treatment plant and the purchase and installation of additional security cameras at various critical infrastructure locations, where needed, based on the recommendations of the Police Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Hanover in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. The governing body hereby authorizes the extension of the Township's fiber optic network on certain streets in the Township, including the installation of fiber optic to connect the Hanover Sewerage Authority's treatment plant, and the acquisition and purchase of additional security cameras to be installed at various critical infrastructure locations in the Township, where needed. The installation of the fiber optic and security cameras shall include all labor, equipment, hardware, materials, and related appurtenances.

SECTION 2. For the acquisition, purchase and installation of additional fiber optic materials, and security cameras as described in **Section 1.**, the governing body authorizes the Department of Administration and/or Police Department to publicly advertise for the receipt of sealed competitive bids, pursuant to the Local Public

Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A: 11-1 et. seq., or utilizing the procurement services through an approved Cooperative Pricing System, at N.J.A.C. 34-7.4 et seq., authorized by the State of New Jersey, or, through a National Cooperative Purchasing Program authorized in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52: 34-6.2(3), or through a valid and current State Contract approved by the Cooperative Purchasing Program of the Division of Purchase and Property in the Department of the Treasury, all in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A: 11-12.a. and N.J.A.C. 5: 34-7.29c.

SECTION 3. For financing the acquisition, purchase and installation of the extended fiber optic network, security cameras, and all related labor, materials and appurtenances described in **Section 1.**, there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$350,000.00 from the 2024 Capital Improvement Fund and all prior years, including the unallocated portion of the Capital Improvement Fund, if necessary.


SECTION 4. In case for any reason, any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, the same shall not affect any other section or provision of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared unconstitutional or invalid shall be severed from the remainder or any portion thereof.

SECTION 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such inconsistency, thereby repealed.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect in accordance with law.


