#### **ORDINANCE NUMBER 2547**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER 133 OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF HASBROUCK HEIGHTS AND, SPECIFICALLY, TO AMEND SECTION 133-21.3 ENTITLED "FEES UNDER CHAPTER 194, PARKS AND RECREATION AREAS."

WHEREAS, Chapter 133 of the Code of the Borough of Hasbrouck Heights controls and regulates fees charged by the Borough; and

WHEREAS, Section 133-21.3 of the Borough Code entitled "Fees, under Chapter 194, Parks and Recreation," states the fees charged for the use Woodland Park; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Hasbrouck Heights has determined that said fees must be updated to address administrative expenses and municipal costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF HASBROUCK HEIGHTS, COUNTY OF BERGEN, AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

### **SECTION ONE:**

Section 133-21.3 of the Code of the Borough of Hasbrouck Heights is amended to delete subsections A(1) through A(6) and replace with the following:

#### (1) Residents:

- (a) 9 to 25: \$200 if the permittee is granted the use of the bathroom facilities;
- (b) 26 to 50: \$225 if the permittee is granted the use of the bathroom facilities;
- (c) 51 to 75: \$250 if the permittee is granted the use of the bathroom facilities;
- (d) 76 to 100: \$275 if the permittee is granted the use of the bathroom facilities;
- (e) More than 100: \$300 if the permittee is granted the use of the bathroom facilities; and

# (2) Non-residents:

- (a) 9 to 25: \$400 if the permittee is granted the use of the bathroom facilities;
- (b) 26 to 50: \$450 if the permittee is granted the use of the bathroom facilities;
- (c) 51 to 75: \$500 if the permittee is granted the use of the bathroom facilities;
- (d) 76 to 100: \$550 if the permittee is granted the use of the bathroom facilities;
- (e) More than 100: \$600 if the permittee is granted the use of the bathroom facilities; and
- (3) Groups of no more than 50, either composed of members of a local, nonprofit, civic, educational, governmental, or religious associations having a membership 50% of which is composed of Borough residents and their nonpaying invitees; or composed of members who regularly perform services to the Borough: \$150, all of which may be refundable as hereafter provided.

# SECTION TWO.

Section 133-21.3 of the Code of the Borough of Hasbrouck Heights is amended to delete subsection B and replace with the following subsections:

- **B.** The Borough Clerk shall charge against the said deposit a sum based upon the estimate of the Superintendent of Public Works of the cost to clean the park after the respective use and the cost to repair any damage resulting from that use, but nevertheless no less than 50% of the deposit, except in respect to applicants referred to in Subsection <u>A(3)</u> above. Any sum thereafter remaining shall be returned to the permittee.
- C. Residents may reserve Woodland Park starting as of February 1st.
- D. Non-residents may reserve Woodland Park starting as of March 1st.

### SECTION THREE. Repealer:

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency only.

# **SECTION FOUR:** Severability:

If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence or other part of this Ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this Ordinance, but shall be confined in its effects to the section, subsection, paragraph, sentence or other part of this Ordinance directly involved in the controversy in which said judgment shall have been rendered and all other provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

### **SECTION FIVE:** Effective Date:

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final adoption and publication and in the manner provided by law.
