RESOLUTIONS

- [Resolution 56-2024](#) – A Resolution approving the Preliminary/Final Subdivision and Land Development Plan submitted by Midtown Redevelopment, LLC to consolidate and subdivide various vacant parcels into multiple project sites to develop single-family and multi-family dwellings, commercial space, and accessory parking along with associated improvements in the area bounded by Reily Street, Fulton Street, Sayford Street, and James Street.

- [Resolution 32-2025](#) – A Resolution approving the Preliminary/Final Land Development Plan for 555 South 25th Street submitted by Commonwealth Charter Academy, to demolish a portion of the existing school building on-site and redevelop the property as a cyber charter school with a larger building footprint and expanded site and access improvements.
