RESOLUTIONS

- [Resolution 16-2026](#) – A Resolution to negotiate and enter into a lease agreement with the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation in the amount of One Dollar (\$1.00) for a certain portion of right-of-way with parking and lighting improvements located under the South Bridge of I-83 to be used as parking for recreational activities on the Capital Area Greenbelt.
