ORDINANCE NO. 2412

INTRODUCED BY Alderman Ash Geers

AN ORDINANCE TO ELECT CHANGES UNDER THE MISSOURI LOCAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the City of Hermann, Missouri, intends to adopt changes to its employee benefits program consistent with the Missouri Local Government Employees Retirement System (“LAGERS”) Benefit Program L-6; and

WHEREAS, the City has complied with the notice and filing requirements of RSMo Section 105.675; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Aldermen understands that by adopting this benefit change, the City is accepting the legal obligation to fund the elected benefits now and in the future, and that it will be financially able to do so; and

WHEREAS, The City will not require contributions from its employees to fund the elected benefits; and will promptly remit employer contributions required by Sections 70.705, 70.730, and 70.735 RSMo.

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen has determined that adopting this benefit change serves a legitimate public purpose and is in the best interests of the citizens of the City of Hermann, Missouri.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF HERMANN, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: The City of Hermann, an employer under LAGERS, hereby elects to adopt a change in the Benefit Program for covered employees, electing Benefit Program L-6 in accordance with RSMo Section 70.655.

SECTION TWO: Mayor Bruce Cox shall certify this election to LAGERS within ten days. Such election shall be effective on the first day of July, 2024.

SECTION THREE: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and adoption.
