TOWNSHIP OF HILLSIDE COUNTY OF UNION, STATE OF NEW JERSEY ORDINANCE NUMBER O-20-04

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TOWNSHIP OF HILLSIDE TOWNSHIP CODE AT CHAPTER 291 (PARKING) SECTION 17 §291.17 (ELIMINATING ON STREET PARKING) OF THE "REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HILLSIDE

WHEREAS, Section 291.17 was adopted by the Governing body to eliminate on Street parking on certain streets within the Township of Hillside; and

WHEREAS, the Township has continuously abided by the aforementioned provisions but seeks to expand upon same based on societal changes; and

WHEREAS, it is the goal of the Township of Hillside to both inform its constituents regarding Township business and to have transparency in government; and.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of Hillside, County of Union, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. Chapter 291 of the "Revised General Ordinance of the Township of Hillside, is hereby amended to read:

Section 291.17 – On Street Parking is prohibited at all times on Emerson Lane: Side: North -- Location: Entire length (Leslie Street to Franklin Street)

AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all provisions of the Township of Hillside Code that are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

- 2. Severability. Each section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase of this Ordinance is declared to be an independent section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase. If any portion of this Ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstances, shall be adjudged or otherwise determined to be invalid, unconstitutional, void, or ineffective for any cause or reason, such determination shall not affect the remaining provisions of this Ordinance, and the application of such remaining provisions shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are severable.
- 3. Conflicts. This Ordinance is not meant to repeal any provisions of the Code, other than those specified herein above, but to add to its requirements, and all Ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed only to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict.

This Ordinance shall take effect 20 days after final passage and publication as provided by law.
