ORDINANCE NUMBER O-21-06

**ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TOWNSHIP OF HILLSIDE TOWNSHIP CODE AT
CHAPTER XI (TRAFFIC) SCHEDULE 11.5 (Exclusion of Trucks 5 Tons or Over) OF THE
“REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HILLSIDE”**

WHEREAS, the Traffic Division investigated the request by the Chief of Police concerning several complaints regarding truck traffic on Eastern Parkway, Paul Street and Purce Street; and

WHEREAS, the investigation revealed that the commercial traffic of vehicles in excess of five (5) tons frequenting a residential area which is highly frequented by pedestrians and juveniles causes a risk to health, life and safety of the constituency of the Township of Hillside; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has concurred with the recommendations therefrom; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of Hillside, County of Union, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. Section 1. Chapter XI of the “Revised General Ordinance of the Township of Hillside”, is hereby amended to read:

Section 11.5 - The following streets are designated as excluded to trucks five (5) tons or over.

AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED to prohibit dual wheel trucks on any residential street having a roadway of less than twenty (20) feet available on a two way street or less than twelve (12) feet on a one way street where such traffic is determined to be a nuisance, a hazard, or otherwise undesirable from a traffic and safety standpoint for the purpose of this section, the available roadway space shall mean the distance between curbs where parking is prohibited parking is permitted on side and less than fourteen (14) feet where parking is permitted on both sides.

AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all provisions of the Township of Hillside Code that are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

2. Severability. Each section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase of this Ordinance is declared to be an independent section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase. If any portion of this Ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstances, shall be adjudged or otherwise determined to be invalid, unconstitutional, void, or ineffective for any cause or reason, such determination shall not affect the remaining provisions of this Ordinance, and the application of such remaining provisions shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are severable.

3. Conflicts. This Ordinance is not meant to repeal any provisions of the Code, other than those specified herein above, but to add to its requirements, and all Ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed only to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict.

This Ordinance shall take effect 20 days after final passage and publication as provided by law.


