ORDINANCE NO.: 6

ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 190-11 ENTITLED LOADING ZONES DESIGNATED TO EXTEND THE LENGTH AND EFFECTIVE HOURS FOR A LOADING ZONE ON WASHINGTON STREET BETWEEN NEWARK STREET AND FIRST STREET

WHEREAS, Chapter 190 of the Hoboken City Code regulates vehicles and traffic on public streets in Hoboken; and,

WHEREAS, §190-11 includes the locations, effective hours, and time limits of loading zones in Hoboken; and,

WHEREAS, the construction of the Rebuild by Design resist structure's southern alignment on Washington Street between Observer Highway and Newark Street may temporarily restrict access to loading space on this block; and,

WHEREAS, to help accommodate loading activities displaced during construction, the existing loading zone located 140 feet away on Washington Street between Newark Street and First Street will be lengthened by 45 feet and the effective hours will be extended by five hours.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Hoboken does hereby Ordain as follows (<u>additions noted in underline</u>, <u>deletions noted in strikethrough</u>):

SECTION ONE: AMENDMENTS TO CHAPTER 190

§190-11 Loading zones designated

SECTION TWO: REPEAL OF INCONSISTENT PROVISIONS

All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict or inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, but only to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency, it being the legislative intent that all such ordinances or part of ordinances now existing or in effect unless the same are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance shall remain in effect.

SECTION THREE: SEVERABILITY

The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable and if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase thereof for any reason be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, subsections, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Ordinance, but shall remaining in effect; it being the legislative intent that this Ordinance shall stand notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

SECTION FOUR: EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication as provided by law.

SECTION FIVE: CODIFICATION

This ordinance shall be a part of the Code of the City of Hoboken as though codified and fully set forth therein. The City Clerk shall have this ordinance codified and incorporated in the official copies of the Code.

The City Clerk and the Corporation Counsel are authorized and directed to change any Chapter, Article and/or Section number of the Code of the City of Hoboken in the event that the codification of this Ordinance reveals that there is a conflict between the numbers and the existing Code, and in order to avoid confusion and possible accidental repealers of existing provisions not intended to be repealed.
