A local law providing for written notification of defects and obstructions on village highways, bridges, streets, sidewalks, crosswalks, and culverts in the Village of Holley

A local law providing for written notification of defects and obstructions on village highways, bridges, streets, sidewalks, crosswalks, and culverts in the Village of Holley

Be it enacted by the Village Board of the Village of Holley.

Section 1. No civil actions shall be maintained against the village or village superintendent of highways for damages or injuries to person or property sustained by reason of any highway, bridge, street, sidewalk, crosswalk, or culvert being defective, out of repair, unsafe, dangerous, or obstructed unless written notice of such defective, unsafe, dangerous, or obstructed condition of such highway, bridge, street, sidewalk, crosswalk, or culvert was actually given to the village clerk or village superintendent of highways, and there was a failure or neglect within reasonable time after the giving of such notice to repair or remove the defect, danger, or obstruction complained of.

No such action shall be maintained for damages or injuries to person or property sustained solely in consequence of the existence of snow or ice upon any highway, bridge, street, sidewalk, crosswalk, or culvert, unless written notice thereof, specifying the particular place, was actually given to the village clerk or village superintendent of highways and there was failure or neglect to cause such snow or ice to be removed, or to make the place otherwise reasonably safe within a reasonable time after the receipt of such notice.

Section 2. The village superintendent of highways shall transmit in writing to the village clerk within five days after receipt thereof all written notices received pursuant to this local law and subdivision 2 of section 65-a of the Village Law. The village clerk shall cause all written notices received pursuant to this local law and subdivision 2 of section 65-a of the Village Law, to be presented to the village board within five days of the receipt thereof or at the next succeeding village board meeting, whichever shall be sooner.

Section 3. This local law shall supersede in its application to the Village of Holley subdivisions 1 and 3 of section 65-a of the Village Law.

Section 4. This local law shall take effect immediately upon its filing in the office of the Secretary of State.

Please note that the Village Law Section 65-a, Subdivision 4, requires the Village Clerk to keep indexed record (by location) of all such notices received. In the event of litigation, the Village will be expected to demonstrate compliance with this provision.
