ORDINANCE NO. 2024-08

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 263
OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF HOLLAND, SHEBOYGAN COUNTY, WISCONSIN

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Board of the Town of Holland, Sheboygan County, Wisconsin, that the following provisions of the Code of the Town of Holland are hereby amended as follows:


I. § 263-8.C is hereby amended to read as follows:


C. The Town declares that all noxious weeds shall be destroyed prior to the time in which such plants would mature to the bloom or flower state. The growth of noxious weeds in excess of eight inches in height from the ground surface shall be prohibited within the Town. "Destroy", as used in this section, shall have the meaning set forth in § 66.0407(1)(a), Wis. Stats. "Noxious weeds", as used in this section, shall mean bull thistle, Canada thistle, field bindweed, Japanese knotweed, leafy spurge, phragmites, any weed designated as a noxious weed by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources by rule, including Wis. Admin. Code Chapter NR 40, and any other weed the Town Board or Sheboygan County Board by ordinance or resolution declares to be noxious within its boundaries.


This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage and posting.




