THE TOWN BOARD, having held a public hearing on the 9th day of July, 2024 at 2:00 p.m. to consider adopting Local Law Introductory No. 25-2024 amending the Uniform Traffic Code of the Town of Huntington, Chapter 2, Article IV, §2-7, Schedule G, and due deliberation having been had; and

WHEREAS, the installation of stop signs is a Type II action pursuant to 6 N.Y.C.R.R 617.5(c)(22) and, therefore, no further review is required.

HEREBY ADOPTS

Section 1. Amendment to the Uniform Traffic Code of the Town of Huntington, Chapter 2, Article IV, §2-7, Schedule G, as follows:

Section 2. Severability.

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section, or other part of this local law shall for any reason be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this local law, and it shall be construed to have been the legislative intent to enact this local law without such unconstitutional or invalid parts therein.

Section 3. Effective Date.

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the Office of the Secretary of the State of New York.
