ORDINANCE NO.23-06

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND RESTATE RELEVANT PORTIONS OF CHAPTER 30 OF THE CODE OF THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF HURON BY DELETING SUBSECTIONS 530-60 A (9) AND (11) AND RE-NUMBERING SUBSECTIONS.

THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF HURON ORDAINS:

Section 1: Deletion of Subsections 530-60 A 9 and 11.

- A. Subsections 530-60 A (9) (Massage Parlor) and A (11) (Tattoo Parlor) are deleted in their entireties.
- B. Subsection 530-60 A (10) is renumbered to A (9).

Section 2: Severability

Should any section, clause or provision of this Ordinance be declared by a Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.

Section 3: Effective Date

The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare, and are hereby ordered to take effect seven days after the publication of a "Notice of Adoption," as required by law.

Publication. This Ordinance was approved and adopted by the Township Board of Huron Charter Township, Wayne County, Michigan on July 12, 2023, after introduction and a first reading on June 14, 2023, and publication after first reading as required by Act 359 of the Michigan Public Acts of 1947, as amended. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon publication of a "Notice of Adoption," in The News Herald, a newspaper having general circulation in the Township.
