ORDINANCE NO. 062024-43

AN ORDINANCE CERTIFYING THE ELECTION RESULTS FOR THE OFFICE OF ONE COUNCIL UNEXPIRED TERM FOR THE CITY OF HUBBARD, TEXAS AND ORDAINING OTHER PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE SUBJECT MATTER THEREOF.

WHEREAS, on March 19, 2024 the General Election was declared cancelled in accordance with Section 3.053 of the Texas Election Code and City Secretary certified unopposed candidates for the office of Three (3) City Council Members full term seats, and;

on May 4, 2024, a Special Election was held in the City of Hubbard, Hill County, Texas for the office of One (1) City Council Member un-expired seat.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HUBBARD THAT;

SECTION 1: After canvassing the returns of said Special Election pursuant to the ordinances of the City of Hubbard and pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Texas Election Code, the canvassing board certifies the following are true and correct results, to-wit:

<u>City Council Un-Expired Term (One seat)</u>: That Evlyn Hawthorne received 54 votes and Brandon Ivy received 98 votes.

Said election was duly called; that notice of said election was given in accordance with the law; and that the canvass of the votes cast in said elections and returns thereof were made in accordance with the law.

Pursuant to the ordinances of the City of Hubbard and applicable provisions of the Texas Election Code:

<u>City Council Un-Expired Term (One seat)</u>: **Brandon Ivy** having received the majority of votes cast is hereby certified to be elected to the City Council of the City of Hubbard and shall commence his term of office after canvassing according Type A General Law Rules and Regulations and the swearing to the oaths of office as required by law.

SECTION 4: If any part or parts of this Ordinance are found to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court having competent jurisdiction, then such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining parts hereof and such remaining parts shall remain in full force and effect, and to that extent this Ordinance is considered severable.

CONSIDERED, PASSED AND APPROVED this 14th day of May 2024 at a regular scheduled meeting of the City Council of the City of Hubbard, at which a quorum was present and which was held in accordance with Chapter 551, Texas Government Code.


