## AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HUTCHINS, TEXAS, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES BY AMENDING APPENDIX A TITLED "FEE SCHEDULE"; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HUTCHINS, TEXAS:

<u>Section 1</u>. That the Code of Ordinances of the City of Hutchins, Texas, is hereby amended by amending Appendix A titled "Fee Schedule", to read as follows:

#### § A6.001 **Ambulance service.**

## AMEND A13.091, INCLUDING TITLE

#### § A13.091 Service connections and tapping fees.

- (a) <u>Water service connection.</u>
  - (1) The city shall install and maintain all water service connections in the streets, alleys, and easements, and shall charge for the installation and maintenance of all such connections a sum sufficient to cover the average cost thereof, such sum to be determined and collected by the utility department and shall be at the following rates:

#### (b) <u>Sanitary sewer connections.</u>

(1) The city shall install all sanitary sewer service connections in the streets, alleys, and easements both inside and outside the city limits. Said service connections shall be

installed from the main to the property line when the sewer main is located in an alley or a street right-of-way; if the sewer main is in an easement, the service connection shall be installed from the sewer main to the easement boundary line. The city shall charge for each sewer lateral connection, the following:

4" lateral	<del>\$750.00</del> \$ 900.00 + Impact Fees
6" lateral	\$900.00 \$1,050.00 + Impact Fees
8" lateral	\$1,050.00 \$1,200.00 + Impact Fees

## (c) <u>Tapping fees.</u>

(1) These above charges shall apply where made in a dirt street, and there shall be an additional charge where the excavation is made in paved or improved streets, as follows:

Concrete paving	\$266.00 per linear foot	
Asphalt paving	\$100.00 per linear foot	
Gavel or shall paving	\$60.00 per linear foot

## § A13.094 Water meter deposits.

Each residential water consumer shall put up seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) one hundred dollars (\$100.00) and each nonresidential (commercial/industrial) water consumer shall put up a one-hundred-dollar (\$100.00) two hundred dollar (\$200.00) meter deposit which may be applied to the payment of any unpaid bills. Deposits shall be applied when consumer accounts are closed.

<u>Section 2</u>. That all provisions of the Ordinances of the City of Hutchins, Texas, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby, repealed, and all other provisions of the Ordinances of the City of Hutchins not in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>Section 3</u>. That should any sentence, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase or Section of this Ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, the same shall not affect

the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part or provision thereof other than the part thereof decided to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid.

<u>Section 4</u>. That an offense committed before the effective date of this ordinance is governed by prior law and the provisions of the Ordinances of the City of Hutchins, as amended, in effect when the offense was committed and the former law is continued in effect for this purpose.

<u>Section 5</u>. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption as the law and charter in such cases provide.
