SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE INTENT

The Village of Island Park has expanded the selection of snacks and Village logo merchandise that is sold at the Masone Beach Snack Shack and the Village Hall office in response to requests from residents.

SECTION 2. VILLAGE HALL OFFICE

The Village Hall Office is authorized to sell Village Logo Merchandise according to the following fee schedule.

SECTION 3. MASONE BEACH SNACK SHACK

The Masone Beach Office/Snack Shack is authorized to sell Village Logo Merchandise and Snacks and provide Beach Rentals according to the following fee schedule.

SECTION 4. FEE SCHEDULE

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY

If a court determines that any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, the court's order or judgement shall not effect, impair, or invalidate the remainder of this local law, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgement or order shall be rendered.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
