## TOWNSHIP OF JACKSON ORDINANCE 23-24

ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF JACKSON, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING CHAPTER 3-122 OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF JACKSON WITH RESPECT TO EXTRA DUTY ASSIGNMENTS WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY

**BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED** by the Township Council of the Township of Jackson, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey that Chapter 3-122 entitled "Extra Duty Assignments" shall be amended to add an additional provision to be designated as 3-122G(4).

**SECTION 1.** 3-122G(4). Once an extra duty assignment has been assigned to a particular officer, any time changes made within twenty-four (24) hours of the original start time, shall result in an additional four (4) hour minimum being charged to the contractor which shall be paid to the assigned officer.

**SECTION 2.** Each section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase of this Ordinance is declared to be an independent section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase, and the finding or holding of any such portion of this Ordinance to be unconstitutional, void, or ineffective for any cause, or reason, shall not affect any other portion of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 3.** This ordinance shall take effect after second reading and publication as required by law.
