RESOLUTIONS

1. WHEREAS, a Neighborhood Watch Committee has been organized in the Holman/Maltby Street area for the purpose of deterring crime in this area, and

WHEREAS, the Holman/Maltby Street Neighborhood Watch Program has the support and approval of the Jamestown Police Department, and

WHEREAS, the Jamestown Police Department has received funding for the purchase of Neighborhood Watch signs with the understanding that the City of Jamestown will erect the signs and assume the responsibility for the maintenance of said signs, now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Director of Public Works be, and he hereby is, authorized to erect and maintain said signs in appropriate places on the aforesaid street.

The members agreed that a resolution be prepared for the January 25, 2016 meeting.

2. RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Police Chief/Director of Public Safety be and they hereby are, authorized to enter into a purchase agreement with Delacy Ford, 3061 Transit Road, Elma, New York 14059 for one (1) 2016 Ford Explorer that will be used as the K-9 vehicle, in an amount not to exceed Twenty-eight Thousand, Four Hundred Forty-one Dollars (\$28,441.00), paid for with Asset Forfeiture Funds subject to the approval of the Corporation Counsel as to form. (Note: This item appears on the Finance Committee Meeting Agenda)

The members agreed that a resolution be prepared for the January 25, 2016 meeting.

3. RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Deputy Fire Chief be, and they hereby are authorized to enter into a purchase agreement with Fire Rescue Products, 4230 Industrial Road, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania 17110 for Paratech rescue equipment in an amount not to exceed Five Hundred Ninety Seven Dollars (\$597.00) in accordance with funding received by the Department of Homeland Security Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program EMW-FO-02860 subject to the approval of the Corporation Counsel as to form.

The members agreed that a resolution be prepared for the January 25, 2016 meeting.
