The Committee reviewed the following:

1. Amendments to Chapter 175 of the City Code.

4. Request from CrossPointe Church to hold services in Potter's Terrace. This was approved with the request that they be respectful of the individual's living in the area.
5. Amendments to Chapter 215 of the City Code that were recommended by the Housing Committee.
6. Resolution authorizing a joint grant application with the Chautauqua County Sheriff's Department in the amount of \$15,848.00.
7. Resolution authorizing a Memorandum of Agreement with the County of Chautauqua to receive funds under the 1005 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program (JAG).
