Acting Chairperson Albert called the meeting to order.

The Committee reviewed the following:

1. Ordinance amendment to exempt parts of Whitehill Avenue and Myrtle Street from the alternate parking regulations thereby restricting parking to one side of the street. It was decided to exempt both streets from Cole Avenue to Smith Avenue as most residents were supportive of the change.
2. Request from the United Veterans Council of Jamestown, New York to hold the annual Memorial Day Parade on May 30, 2005.

Carried: 2 ayes, 0 nays

Chief MacLaughlin updated the Committee on the status of the negotiations with the Humane Society. They are currently in a holding pattern and he is looking into other options. He also is looking into what kind of information the New York State Attorney General will need to review the issue.

The Committee will hold an Executive Session on April 25, 2005 at 6:30 p.m. in the Mayor's Conference room to discuss specific claims and possibly a brief open session to consider one or more special event applications.
