Chairman Calamunci called the meeting to order.

Chairman Calamunci distributed a sample parking ticket. The Committee asked how many tickets are issued annually. Deputy Chief Shaver replied approximately 25,000. They discussed how many tickets should be ordered and Mr. DeStefano said that he and Chief MacLaughlin were planning on ordering a six month supply due to the pending grant application to purchase hand-held units for the issuance of parking tickets. Deputy Chief Shaver advised that no matter how many tickets were ordered, there would still be a set-up charge. They discussed the advantages of having hand-held units for the issuance of parking tickets. Mr. DeStefano explained the current process for notification and scofflaw violations.
