Chairman Joy called the meeting to order.

The Committee reviewed the following resolutions:

1. Resolution authorizing a contract with the Chautauqua County Humane Society.
2. Resolution granting a vendor waiver to the Chautauqua Region Quilt Guild.

Items approved

The Committee discussed a request for a stop sign at Prather Avenue and South Main Street. This was referred to the Department of Public Works for their recommendation. The Police Department will also review this intersection.

Chief MacLaughlin advised that the crime mapping software was being installed and the first meeting for the imaging system was scheduled for January 12<sup>th</sup>. He stated that a travel request for Deputy Chief Wallace had been sent for approval. He also briefly reviewed a Local Law being considered by the Chautauqua County Legislature restricting the use of devices that could result in driver inattention (cell phones, etc.) expressing concerns that this would be very difficult to enforce.

Chairman Joy advised the Committee of a street light request and a complaint about a street light that was not working.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
