Acting Chairman Joy called the meeting to order.

The Committee reviewed the results of the Goals and Objectives of the Jamestown Police Department for the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter of 1999 and the progress report and calls made by the Jamestown Fire Department.

The Committee reviewed the following resolutions:

1. Resolution authorizing the placement of neighborhood watch signs for the Harris Avenue and Euclid Avenue Neighborhood Watch programs.
2. Resolution authorizing Chief MacLaughlin to attend the F.B.I. Law Enforcement Executive Development Training Course in Quantico, Virginia.
3. Resolution authorizing an agreement with Chautauqua County for STOP-DWI services.
4. Resolution authorizing the lease/purchase of five 1999 Crown Victoria Sedans from Warnock Fleet and Leasing Corporation.
5. Resolution authorizing Chief Arcadipane, and Investigators Winchester and Conti to attend the 1999 New York State Fire Investigators Spring Seminar in Niagara Falls, New York.
6. Resolution authorizing the lease/purchase of one 1999 Suburban from Shults Chevrolet.
7. Resolution designating the polling places in the City of Jamestown for 1999.
8. Resolution approving the subdivision map submitted by Creekside Leisure Living Development and modifying the zoning regulations to the limited extent necessary to allow the number of units proposed in the subdivision map.

#### Unfinished Business

The Committee reviewed the request from the organizers of Lucy-Desi Days to close a portion of Pine Street and utilize the sidewalk on 3<sup>rd</sup> Street from Prendergast Avenue to Main Street on May 28-30, 1999. Acting Chairman Joy voiced concerns that all the affected businesses had not expressed their opinion. Councilman Dolce stated that he felt the use of the sidewalk on Pine Street from the Museum north to 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and the sidewalk on 3<sup>rd</sup> Street between Prendergast Avenue and Main Street was sufficient.

Item approved for use of sidewalk only

The Towing Ordinance was tabled for further study.

The local law to require that the General Manager of the Board of Public Utilities be confirmed by City Council was discussed. The consensus of the Committee was not to go forward with this local law; but require that the General Manager attend the City Council work sessions. The Mayor will be asked to notify the General Manger of the Council's request.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
