1. Resolution authorizing Jennifer R. Williams to attend the NYCOM Annual Meeting on June 9th – 11th at the Sagamore Hotel in Bolton Landing, New York with expenses paid pursuant to Section 77-b of the General Municipal Law.
2. Resolution authoring the payment of Three Hundred Seventy-Nine Thousand, Eight Hundred Eighty-Four Dollars and Ten Cents (\$379,884.10) in accordance with the bond and note requirement as follows:

Public Improvement Bonds, Refunding of 2010A BONDS, issue of March 19, 2019, Three Hundred Thirty-Three Thousand, Nine Hundred Eleven Dollars and No Cents (\$333,911.00) principal and Forty-Five Thousand, Nine Hundred Seventy-Three Dollars and Ten Cents (\$45,973.10) for six months interest at 5% per annum on One Million, Eight Hundred Thirty-Eight Thousand, Nine Hundred Twenty-Four Dollars and No Cents (\$1,838,924.00).
3. Resolution authorizing the payment of Three Hundred Four Thousand, Five Hundred Dollars and No Cents (\$304,500.00) in accordance with the bond and note requirement as follows:

Public Improvement Bonds, Refunding of 2011 Series A Bonds, issue of October 15, 2020, Two Hundred Sixty Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$260,000.00) principal and Forty-Four Thousand, Five Hundred Dollars and No Cents (\$44,500.00) for six months interest at 5% per annum on One Million, Seven Hundred Eighty Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$1,780,000.00).
4. Resolution authorizing the Mayor to enter into an agreement with Highmark Life Insurance Company of New York, placed through Premier Consulting Associates, LLC, 1416 Sweet Home Road, Amherst, New York 14228, for a specific excess stop-loss insurance policy for the period June 1, 2021 through May 31, 2022 in the amount of One Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$175,000.00) for specific deductible, annual unlimited maximum reimbursement, at a cost of Sixty-Seven Dollars and Seven cents (\$67.07) per covered participant, per month, subject to the approval of the Corporation Counsel as to form.

5. Resolution authorizing the Mayor to execute a grant agreement with the NYS Environmental Facilities Corporation and any and all other contracts, documents and instruments necessary to bring about the project and to fulfill the City of Jamestown's obligations under the Grant Agreement, subject to review and approval by Corporation Counsel as to form.
