1           **AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO**  
2           **EXECUTE CHANGE ORDER NO. 1 FOR THE FORD SUPER DUTY TRUCKS 2024**  
3           **CONTRACT FOR THE JEFFERSON COUNTY, MISSOURI, DEPARTMENT OF**  
4           **PUBLIC WORKS.**

5           **WHEREAS**, Pursuant to Ordinance 23-0474, Jefferson County, Missouri and the  
6           Department of Public Works, Division of Fleet Services entered into a Contract, known as  
7           the Ford Super Duty Trucks 2024 Contract, with Reuther Ford for \$52,000.00; and,

8           **WHEREAS**, the Department of Public Works, Division of Fleet Services of  
9           Jefferson County, Missouri finds that it is now necessary to adjust the estimated amount of  
10          the Ford Super Duty Trucks 2024 Contract; and

11          **WHEREAS**, the need for the adjustment is due to market availability of trucks  
12          needed; and

13          **WHEREAS**, the Department of Public Works intends to purchase six (6) F-250  
14          pickup trucks; and

15          **WHEREAS**, Jefferson County, Missouri and the Department of Public Works,  
16          Division of Fleet Services for Jefferson County, hereby request an increase of an additional  
17          Two Hundred Seventy-Seven Thousand, Five Hundred Sixty Dollars (**\$277,560.00**) to the  
18          Ford Super Duty Trucks 2024 with Reuther Ford; and,

1           **WHEREAS** Jefferson County, Missouri, Council finds that it is now necessary and  
2 in the best interest of the County to execute Change Order No. 1 to the Ford Super Duty  
3 Trucks 2024 Contract with Reuther Ford, for an increase of Two Hundred Seventy-Seven  
4 Thousand, Five Hundred Sixty Dollars (**\$277,560.00**) to the contract sum, subject to  
5 budgetary limitations; for a revised total of Three Hundred Twenty-Nine Thousand, Five  
6 Hundred Sixty Dollars (**\$329,560.00**) for the Ford Super Duty Trucks 2024 Contract upon  
7 approval.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE JEFFERSON COUNTY, MISSOURI, COUNCIL,  
AS FOLLOWS:**

8           Section 1.     The Contract with Reuther Ford for the Ford Super Duty Trucks 2024  
9 Contract shall be increased by Two Hundred Seventy-Seven Thousand, Five Hundred Sixty  
10 Dollars (**\$277,560.00**) for a revised total cost of Three Hundred Twenty-Nine Thousand,  
11 Five Hundred Sixty Dollars (**\$329,560.00**), subject to budgetary limitations.

12           Section 2.     The Jefferson County, Missouri, Council hereby authorizes the County  
13 Executive to execute Change Order No. 1 to the Ford Super Duty Trucks 2024 Contract with  
14 Reuther Ford, and any agreements or contracts necessary to effectuate the award of the bids  
15 and proposals set forth in this Ordinance. The County Executive is further authorized to take  
16 any and all actions necessary to carry out the intent of this Ordinance.

17           Section 3.     Copies of all Invitations for Bid, response thereto, any contract  
18 agreements and change orders shall be maintained by the Department of the County Clerk  
19 consistent with the rules and procedures for the maintenance and retention of records as  
20 promulgated by the Secretary of State.


1            Section 4.      This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its date  
2 of approval. If any part of this Ordinance is invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not  
3 affect the remainder of this Ordinance.


