AGREEMENT FORM

THIS AGREEMENT is dated as of <u>April 16</u>, in the year 2024 by and between JEFFERSON COUNTY, MISSOURI (hereinafter called OWNER OR COUNTY) and <u>NB West Contracting Co.</u> (hereinafter called CONTRACTOR).

OWNER and CONTRACTOR, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein after set forth and in the mount of \$1,961,507.42 , agree as follows:

ARTICLE 1. WORK

CONTRACTOR shall complete all work as specified or indicated in the Contract Decuments for the

2024 Pavement Surface Preservation, Projection PW24000PSP

The work includes:

The proposed work includes approximately 17.75 miles of 3/8" trap fick with CRS-2P of parement preservation, as well as 9.36 miles of UBAWS, Type C pavement preservation to various roadways. Straing, rumble strips, and traffic control are also included within this contract.

ARTICLE 2. ENGINEER

The County has designated the Public Works Director, who is ben in the called ENGINEER and who has the authority assigned to OWNER in the Contract Documents in connection with completion of the Work in accordance with the Contract Documents.

ARTICLE 3. CONTRACT TIME

3.1 The work will be completed and ready for final payment in accordance with Section 30 of the General Provisions by the completion date or November 1, 2024.

Allowances will be made for weather conditions and other occurrences beyond the control of the CONTRACTOR. If the CONTRACTOR is unable to begin work as required, the ENGINEER shall be notified in writing. Unless the ENGINEER gives we can approval for a delay in beginning the work, days will begin to be counted for liquidated damages. The count will continue that the CONTRACTOR begins full operation. 3.2 CONTRACTOR agree, that the work will be completed within the time period specified below or the contractor shall pay the County, not as a penalty but as liquidated damages, a sum equal to the amount specified below for each day, as defined by Sec 108 of the __2023 __edition of the "Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction", elapsing between the _xpiration of such time limit, excluding any extensions of time granted through executed Change Order(s):

LIQUIDATED DAMAGES: \$ 1,100.00 or One Thousand One Hundred Dollars per Day



ARTICLE 5. PAYMENT PROCEDURES

Contractor shall submit Application for Payment in accordance with Section 33 of the General Provisions. The Engineer as provided in the General Provisions will process application for Payment.

- 5.1 Progress Payment. Owner will make progress payments per the Contract Bid Price on the basis of the Contractor's Application of Payment as recommended by the Engineer, on or about the First day of each month during the construction as provided below. All progress payments will be on the basis of the Work measured on the job site according to unit of measurement as shown within the job special provisions or classocari Standard Specifications.
- 5.1.1 The Engineer may initiate withholding of retainage as provided by Section 109.9 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction. Release of any retained percentage shall be a provided by Section 109.9.
- 5.1.2 When the Contractor receives any payment from the Engineer, the Contractor sear hake prompt payment to subcontractors and suppliers as provided by Section 109.13 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction.
- 5.2 Final Payment. Upon final completion and acceptance of the Work in a cord, ace with Sections 32-33 of the

General Provisions, Owner shall pay the remainder of the Controct Price as recomme ded by the ENGINEER. ARTICLE

CONTRACTOR'S REPRESENTATIONS

In order to induce the County to enter into this Agreement CONTRACTOR makes the following representations:

- 6.1 CONTRACTOR has familiarized themselve with the nature and leaven of the Contract Documents, Work, locality, and with all local conditions and federal laws, sate and local laws, ordinarces, rules and regulations that in any manner may affect cost, progress or performance of the Work.
- 6.2 CONTRACTOR has studied carefully all reports of incestigations and tests of subsurface and latent physical conditions at the site of otherwise affecting cost, progress or performance of the Work which were relied upon by the ENGINEER in the programion of the Drawings and Specifications. When the information is available it will either be included in the bild documents or hade available at the Jefferson County Department of Public Works for the Contractor's review.
- 6.3 CONTRACTOR has made or caused by a made examinations, investigations and tests and studies of such reports and related data in addition to those referred to in Article 9 as they deem necessary for the performance on the Work at the Contract Price, within the Contract Time and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Contract Vocuments; and no additional examinations, investigations, tests, reports or similar data will be required by CONTRACTOR for such purposes.
- 6.4 CONTRACTOR has correlated the results of all such observations, examinations, investigations, tests, reports and data with the terms and conditions of the Contract Documents.
- 6.5 CONTRACTOR has given ENGINEER written notice of all conflicts, errors or discrepancies that they have discovered in the Contract Documents and the written resolution thereof by ENGINEER is acceptable to CONTRACTOR.

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ARTICLE 7. CONTRACT DOCUMENTS

The Contract Documents which comprise the entire agreement between OWNER and CONTRACTOR are attached to this Agreement, made a part hereof and consists of the following:

ARTICLE 8. MISCELLANEOUS


- 8.1 Terms used in this Agreement which are defined in Section 1 of the General Provisions shall have the meanings indicated in the General Provisions.
- 8.2 No assignment by a party herete of any rights under or interests in the Contract Documents will be binding on another party hereto attract the written consent of the party sought to be bound; and specifically but attheut limitation, moreys that may become due and moneys that are due may not be assigned without such consent (except to the extent that the effect of this restriction may be limited by law), and unless specifically stated to the contrary in any written consent to an assignment, no assignment will release or discharge the assign or from any duty or responsibility under the Contract Documents.
- 8.3 The County and CONTRACTOR each binds themselves, their partners, successors, assigns and legal representatives to the other party hereto, their partners, successors, assigns and legal representatives in respect to all covenants, agreements and obligations contained in the Contract Documents.

ARTICLE 9. OTHER PROVISIONS

- 9.1 Access to records. In connection with this Contract the County shall have access to any books, documents, papers, and records of the CONTRACTOR, which are directly pertinent to this project for the purpose of making an audit, examination, excerpts, and transcriptions.
- 9.2 Applicable Laws and Regulations. The CONTRACTOR expressly agrees to comply with all applicable rules and regulations as set forth in the Contract Documents or as may be required by law, and further agrees to submit all certifications, notices, and affirmative action plans as may now or negative be required, and to place such conditions and provisions in any and all subcontracts as may be required.
- 9.3 Conflict of Interest. The CONTRACTOR covenants that they presently have not interest of any kind and shall not acquire any type of interest, direct or indirect, in the program or any property therein, which would conflict in any manner or degree with the performance of their services and obligation hereunder. The CONTRACTOR further covenants that in the performance of this contract, no person known to have any conflicting interest shall be knowingly employed in the performance of this Contract.

ARTICLE 10. VENUE

10.1 It is agreed by the parties that any action at law, suit in equity of other judicial placeding to enforce or construe this Agreement, or regarding its alleged breach, shall be instituted only in the Circuit Court of Jefferson County, Missouri.
