1 **AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO**
2 **EXECUTE CHANGE ORDER NO. 1 FOR THE EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT AND**
3 **INSTALL 2022 CONTRACT FOR THE JEFFERSON COUNTY, MISSOURI,**
4 **DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS.**

5 **WHEREAS**, Pursuant to Ordinances 22-0552, 23-0436 and 23-0481, Jefferson
6 County, Missouri and the Department of Public Works, Division of Fleet Services entered
7 into a Contract, known as the Emergency Equipment and Install 2022 Contract, with Public
8 Safety Upfitters, Defender Product Solutions, and Ed Roehr Safety Products for \$150,000.00
9 per term; and,

10 **WHEREAS**, the Department of Public Works, Division of Fleet Services of
11 Jefferson County, Missouri finds that it is now necessary to adjust the estimated amount of
12 the Emergency Equipment and Install 2022 Contract; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the need for the adjustment is due to the number of vehicles that need
14 to be upfitted; and

15 **WHEREAS**, there are vehicle mounted computer stands for the Code Enforcement
16 and Planning and Zoning Departments; and

17 **WHEREAS**, there are three Chevrolet Tahoe's that are out for bid currently that will
18 need to be upfitted; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Jefferson County, Missouri and the Department of Public Works,
2 Division of Fleet Services for Jefferson County, hereby request an increase of an additional
3 Sixty-One Thousand Dollars (**\$61,000.00**) to the Emergency Equipment and Install 2022
4 with Public Safety Upfitters, Defender Product Solutions, and Ed Roehr Safety Products;
5 and,

6 **WHEREAS**, Jefferson County, Missouri, Council finds that it is now necessary and
7 in the best interest of the County to execute Change Order No. 1 to the Emergency
8 Equipment and Install 2022 Contract with Public Safety Upfitters, Defender Product
9 Solutions, and Ed Roehr Safety Products, for an increase of Sixty-One Thousand Dollars
10 (**\$61,000.00**) to the contract sum, subject to budgetary limitations; for a revised total of Two
11 Hundred and Eleven Thousand Dollars (**\$211,000.00**) for the Emergency Equipment and
12 Install 2022 Contract upon approval.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE JEFFERSON COUNTY, MISSOURI, COUNCIL,
AS FOLLOWS:**

13 Section 1. The Contract with Public Safety Upfitters, Defender Product
14 Solutions, and Ed Roehr Safety Products for the Emergency Equipment and Install 2022
15 Contract shall be increased by Sixty-One Thousand Dollars (**\$61,000.00**) for a revised total
16 cost of Two Hundred and Eleven Thousand Dollars (**\$211,000.00**), subject to budgetary
17 limitations, upon approval by the County Council and County Executive.

18 Section 2. The Jefferson County, Missouri, Council hereby authorizes the County
19 Executive to execute Change Order No. 1 to the Emergency Equipment and Install 2022
20 Contract with Public Safety Upfitters, Defender Product Solutions, and Ed Roehr Safety

1 Products, and any agreements or contracts necessary to effectuate the award of the bids and
2 proposals set forth in this Ordinance. The County Executive is further authorized to take any
3 and all actions necessary to carry out the intent of this Ordinance.

4 Section 3. Copies of all Invitations for Bid, response thereto, any contract
5 agreements and change orders shall be maintained by the Department of the County Clerk
6 consistent with the rules and procedures for the maintenance and retention of records as
7 promulgated by the Secretary of State.

8 Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its date
9 of approval. If any part of this Ordinance is invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not
10 affect the remainder of this Ordinance.


