

ORDINANCE NO. 03-23

STATE OF WISCONSIN: VILLAGE OF JOHNSON CREEK: JEFFERSON COUNTY

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING AND RECREATING SECTION 184-1 B. (3), AND
CREATING SECTION 184-1 B. (26) OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE**

THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF JOHNSON CREEK, JEFFERSON COUNTY,
WISCONSIN, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Section 184-1 B. (3) is hereby repealed and recreated to read as follows:

- (3) Pets. Pets are permitted within the boundaries of Crossroads Landing Park in accordance with this Section. All pets shall be leashed and remain under the strict control of the person accompanying the pet. The person accompanying a pet shall remove and dispose of any fecal matter caused by the animal. Except for Crossroads Landing Park, no pets are permitted within the boundaries of any Village park at any time.

SECTION 2: Section 184-1 B. (26) is hereby created to read as follows:

- (26) Crossroads Landing Boat Launch. A person may only launch a kayak, canoe, or other nonmotorized boat from the Crossroads Landing Boat Launch. It shall be unlawful to launch a motorboat from the Crossroads Landing Boat Launch. No person shall use the Crossroads Landing Boat Launch to bathe, wade, or swim within the Rock River. All other regulations relating to Village parks apply to the Crossroads Landing Boat Launch.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with or contravening the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and posting as provided by law.
